Mr J Bleijie asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

My question without notice is to the Premier. On 2 September the Deputy Premier and education minister announced the new principal of the Inner City South State Secondary College in a video. The video was filmed with the new principal and was posted on the Deputy Premier's Facebook page. At the end of the video, the Labor Party logo appears. I table copies of the screenshots of the video showing the Labor Party logo.

How can Queenslanders have confidence in the independent selection of school principals when the government is applying Labor Party branding to principal announcements?

ANSWER:

I am advised that the announcement was originally made on the Ministerial Statements website. The Minister for Education and Member for South Brisbane followed this up with a social media post.

I am advised that the ALP logo was used in error in that post. The logo was subsequently removed.
