QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline what auditing processes were undertaken in the last year for disability access and inclusion, within state schools in Queensland?

ANSWER:

To inform future policy and provide greater guidance to state schools, the Department of Education's Internal Audit Branch has examined and assessed processes in place at schools to manage and monitor attendance of students with disability on attendance plans. Regional staff support teachers and leaders in Queensland state schools to improve their inclusive education classroom practices.

The department is supporting state schools to implement inclusive education practices by working with regions to develop the capability of their staff.
