Question on Notice No. 343 Asked on 27 March 2019

MR M CRANDON ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the call for service data and the QPrime tasks data, separately for each Police Division in the Gold Coast District, for the period 1 June 2018 to 28 February 2019?

ANSWER:

It is important to note that the Queensland Police Service (QPS) has advised that assigned tasks and Calls for Service are two completely different activities and are in no way comparable.

Assigned tasks are not solely a result of calls for service.

Similarly, not all calls for service require an assigned task.

By way of explanation, consider this.

It may be tempting to conclude that because there are more calls for service in a particular division than the number of assigned tasks, police are not responding appropriately.

This would be a false assumption.

Multiple calls for service could produce a single tasking, therefore any attempt to compare the figures is meaningless.

I am advised by the QPS that assigned tasks are stored in Queensland Police Records and Information Management Exchange (QPRIME) and calls for service are recorded in the Queensland Computer Aided Dispatch (QCAD) system for the Gold Coast Police District.

QPS has advised that tasking is the ability to manage activities required for an investigation through creating and assigning individual tasks to appropriate organisational units or QPS staff members to action.

In relation to the Member's question, QPS has provided the following information in relation to assigned tasks:
