Mrs D Frecklington asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the government's Action on Ice strategy—

Will the Premier provide an update on the status of all outlined action items and whether they are complete, partially complete or incomplete (reported separately per action item)?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government is committed to collaboratively tackling the harmful use and effects of crystal methamphetamine (ice) that are currently challenging many people.

Action on ice – the Queensland Government's plan to address use and harms caused by crystal methamphetamine outlines a program of initiatives to address the impacts of ice use and harms that build on previous achievements in responding to alcohol and other drugs. The long-term goal of *Action on ice* is to address the impacts of ice use on individuals, families and communities. A total of \$105.5 million over five years has been committed to implement initiatives to reduce the supply, demand and harms from ice.
