**MR D JANETZKI** ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE (HON Y D'ATH) –

## QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise how many reportable offenders subject to the Child Protection (Offender Reporting and Offender Prohibition Order) Act 2004 who failed to comply with their reporting obligations were sentenced to imprisonment from 2015 to 2018 (reported separately by year)?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Toowoomba South for his question.

I am advised that the number of offenders who failed to comply with their reporting obligations under the *Child Protection (Offender Reporting and Offender Prohibition Order) Act 2004*, and were sentenced to a term of imprisonment, from 2015 to 2018 is contained in the below table.
