## Asked on 2 April 2019

**MS R BATES** asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES)—

## **QUESTION**

Will the Minister advise how many elective surgeries were cancelled on Tuesday 26 March 2019, Wednesday 27 March 2019 and Thursday 28 March 2019 (reported separately by day and by hospital in South-East Queensland)?

## **ANSWER**

I am advised that over the three days, Tuesday 26 March to Thursday 28 March 2019, more than 1,000 elective surgeries were conducted in South-East Queensland hospitals, and only 14 elective surgery bookings were rescheduled due to a significant increase in bed demand as follows:
