MR D JANETZKI ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (HON G GRACE)

#### QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline (reported separately by year) (a) the number of total year 1 students (as at Day 8) in Queensland state schools for 2015 to 2019 and (b) any projected forecasts for 2020 to 2022?

## ANSWER:

The total of actual Year 1 students enrolled as at Day 8 in Queensland state schools for 2015 to 2019 and the total projected Year 1 for the period 2020 to 2022 are provided in the table below.

The Department of Education reviews and updates enrolment projections each year based on the latest data available.
