MS C MCMILLAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister update the Mansfield Electorate about the Palaszczuk Government's support to secure the police vehicles at Upper Mt Gravatt Police Station?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the Upper Mt Gravatt Police Facility houses a fleet of approximately 45 police vehicles inclusive of general duties, road policing and crime and support services vehicles.

QPS has advised that the funding for a new solid barrier steel fencing has been approved for the Upper Mt Gravatt Police Facility with construction commencing on 2 April 2019.

These works will enhance the security of police vehicles parked on site.

I note the Member's strong advocacy regarding this matter and thank the Member for raising this matter with me.
