QUESTION:

Will the Minister detail how many times the full Better Regulation Taskforce has met in-person since it was established?

ANSWER:

The Better Regulation Taskforce (the Taskforce) was established in 2017 as a sub-committee to the Queensland Small Business Advisory Council (the Council).

The members of the Taskforce do tremendous work, volunteering their years of experience to help improve regulatory environments for Queensland businesses. Previous work of the Taskforce has provided valuable direction for the future regulatory environment of the eco-tourism, live music entertainment and start-up sectors.

In 2017, the Taskforce met on five occasions (including one combined Council and Taskforce meeting).

In 2018, the Taskforce met on five occasions (including one combined Council and Taskforce meeting and one out-of-session meeting).

In 2019, the Taskforce has met twice so far, with a further three meetings anticipated to be held (including one combined Council and Taskforce meeting).
