MR T NICHOLLS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT, MANUFACTURING, INFRASTRUCTURE AND PLANNING (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Yeronga Priority Development Area—

Will the Minister detail what environmental and public health risk assessment work was undertaken before site works commenced?

ANSWER:

The contractor that was appointed as a result of a tender process to dismantle and remove all TAFE buildings was required to have the appropriate experience and qualifications to ensure the demolition of the former TAFE structures was at all times in accordance with the relevant legislation, regulation and code of practice that govern the management and disposal of such materials. This includes:

- Work Place Health and Safety Queensland "How to Safely Remove Asbestos" code of practice 2011
- Queensland Work Health and Safety Act 2011
- Queensland Work Health and Safety Regulations 2011.
