Question on Notice No. 641 Asked on Tuesday, 30 April 2019

MR J BLEIJIE ASKED MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS; MINISTER FOR DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY; MINISTER FOR SPORT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to the state government owned unit complex at 16 Robe Street, Currimundi—

Will the Minister confirm (a) that the original intended use of the property prior to and following its original purchase was primarily for the accommodation of victims escaping domestic and family violence and why has that intention changed, (b) the total amount spent on any maintenance, refurbishment or works by individual unit number and year since 2015, (c) the total number of police recorded incidences (either presentation by police at the property or police reported incident) by unit number and year since 2015 and (d) if there was recently a drug lab discovered in one of the units?

ANSWER

- (a) The property at 16 Robe Street, Currimundi was acquired for general rental stock purposes to accommodate people from the housing register in 1991. The original and current use of the property has remained unchanged.
- (b) The below table outlines the total amount spent on maintenance, refurbishment or works by individual unit number and year since 2015. Figures include disability modifications, and standard items such as electrical works and pest treatments.
