QUESTION:

With reference to the departments Advancing Clean Energy Schools program—

Will the Minister advise the anticipated or targeted energy savings from the \$97m investment over the next three years to 2020-21, in dollar terms and confirm whether this is considered as part of the procurement process?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government will invest \$97 million as part of the Advancing Clean Energy Schools (ACES) program over three years to reduce state school energy costs in more than 800 Queensland state schools through solar and energy efficiency measures.

One of the key objectives of the ACES program is to realise energy savings of an estimated \$10.2 million annually once the program is fully implemented.
