**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise what measures the Queensland Government has in place to ensure biosecurity hazards are not imported (such as foot-and-mouth disease), due to increased multi-national activity planned at Shoalwater Bay and other military facilities?

**ANSWER:**

The Australian Government, through the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Defence including the Australian Defence Force, have primary responsibility for managing biosecurity hazards coming into Australia and on military facilities.
