## QUESTION

Will the Minister provide a list of the available permanent beds per Queensland Health public hospital as at 1 January 2017, 1 January 2018 and 1 January 2019 (reported separately by year and by hospital)?

## ANSWER

The number of available beds and bed alternatives fluctuates over time due to a number of factors, such as patient demand, hospital renovations and refurbishments, transferral of services, and opening/closing of facilities.

Information on the number of beds at Queensland public hospitals is available at <u>www.myhospitals.gov.au</u>.

Detailed data for the number of available beds and bed alternatives for public acute hospitals is published online by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW) in the *Hospital resources series*.
