Mrs D Frecklington asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the decision to transition 17 year olds from adult prisons to the youth justice system and the cabinet sub-committee established to oversee the policy—

Will the Premier advise (a) how many meetings the committee held, (b) the names of the members of the committee and (c) the specific dates of the committee meetings?

ANSWER:

The Youth Justice Cabinet Committee has held 9 meetings.

The membership for the first term of the Palaszczuk Government was:— Ministers D’Ath, Pitt, Dick, Jones, Enoch, Fentiman, de Brenni, Ryan, O’Rourke and Furner

The current membership is: – Ministers D’Ath, de Brenni, O’Rourke and Farmer

Other Ministers who are not standing members are invited to meetings as required.

The Committee has met on the following dates:

2017 – 20 March, 9 August, 15 August, 6 September, 7 September, 23 October

2018 – 18 January, 9 February
