**MR S O'CONNOR ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—**

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise (a) the number of people charged under s 92 of the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 for 2016 to 2020 to date (reported separately by year and type of harm) and (b) the number of investigations that are still ongoing (reported separately by type of harm)?

**ANSWER:**

I have been advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that to provide this detailed information would require manual examination of individual records. Further, I am advised by the QPS that this would take one person approximately 16.25 days, which the QPS consider an unjustifiable use of police resources.

However, I appreciate the Member's interest in this matter. As such, the QPS has advised that there were 84 unique individuals charged under section 92 of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* in 2016, 80 in 2017, 113 in 2018 and 63 in 2019.
