MR M CRANDON asked the Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

Will the Minister outline (a) the number of Queensland Health or Hospital and Health Service FTE employees that were recruited in 2018-19 and (b) of those, the breakdown of clinical and nonclinical employees?

ANSWER

In 2018-19, Queensland Health had 9,926.36 new appointments on a full-time equivalent (FTE) basis. This comprised:

- 5,828.75 FTE clinicians; and
- 4,097.61 FTE non-clinicians, of which 1,443.94 were in frontline roles.
