MR D JANETZKI - ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE (HON Y D'ATH) –

QUESTION:

With respect to hit and run incidents which have resulted in grievous bodily harm or death and in circumstances where the court determined the offender showed a callous disregard—

Will the Attorney-General advise (reported separately by year and type of harm) (a) the number of people convicted of the offence 'Duties and liabilities of drivers involved in road incidents' under s 92 of the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 who showed a callous disregard as provided in subsection (4) between 2016-2020 to date, (b) the shortest period of imprisonment imposed between 2016-2020 to date and (c) the longest period of imprisonment imposed between 2016-2020 to date?

ANSWER:

I am advised that it is not possible to identify from the Courts case management system which offences under section 92 of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* resulted in grievous bodily harm or death.
