MR D PURDIE asked the Minister for Children and Youth Justice and Minister Multicultural Affairs (HON L LINARD)—

QUESTION

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 437 asked on 19 May 2020—

Will the Minister advise (a) the number of children detained in all watch houses across the state since April 2020 to date (reported separately by month), (b) how many of the children identify as being of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent and (c) how many of the detained children are remanded for (i) serious offences as defined in section 8 of the Youth Justice Act and (ii) indictable offences?

ANSWER

This question was asked as part of Question 16 of the Community Support and Services Committee Estimates 2020 pre-hearing questions on notice falling within my portfolio responsibilities.
