DR M ROBINSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) the number of illegal campfires occurring at the King Island Conservation Park off Willington Point from 2017 to 2019 (reported separately by year) and (b) what measures have been take to cease this activity and restore safety to the general public acceding the area on foot?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The King Island Conservation Park falls within the native title claim area of the Quandamooka people. Therefore, under the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2019, this question should be asked of the Minister for Employment and Small Business and Minister for Training and Skills Development.

I refer the Member to the relevant Minister.
