**MR A POWELL ASKED MINISTER FOR INNOVATION AND TOURISM
INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT AND MINISTER FOR CROSS RIVER RAIL
(HON K JONES)—**

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Government's best practice industrial relations requirements as part of the State procurement policy—

Will the Minister advise what financial implications the requirements will have on the construction costs for the Cross River Rail project, including whether any modelling has been undertaken by the Cross River Rail Delivery Authority?

ANSWER:

The Palaszczuk Government has committed \$5.4 billion for the Cross River Rail project.

As compulsory compliance with the Government's Best Practice Principles for industrial relations is written into the contracts with Pulse and Unity Alliance, there are no additional financial implications to the State.
