Mr T Mander asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise on a whole of government basis, how many KPMG, EY, Deloitte and PwC employees are currently on interchange arrangements within the Public Service broken down by consulting firm and department?

ANSWER:

Section 184 of the *Public Service Act 2008* (the Act) allows the Chief Executive of a government department to give effect to an interchange arrangement under which a person employed by or within a private or public company performs duties in a department.

I am advised that as at 18 February 2020, three employees from KPMG were employed in Queensland Treasury on interchange arrangements in accordance with the Act.

I am also advised that as at 18 February 2020, no other employees from KPMG, EY, Deloitte or PwC were employed in government departments on interchange arrangements in accordance with the Act.
