**Mrs D Frecklington** asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier detail the total cost of the machinery-of-government, office changes and any other costs incurred due to the latest Cabinet reshuffle formally announced on 20 September 2019 (reported separately by ministerial office and department (including the Cross River Rail Delivery Authority))?

ANSWER:

The change to the ministry that took place on 20 September 2019 resulted from my decision to move ministerial responsibility for Cross River Rail to the Honourable Kate Jones MP.

The portfolio title of Commonwealth Games was also taken out of Minister Jones' ministerial title at that time, given her completion of a very successful Commonwealth Games. Her department was also renamed to reflect this.

Costs of \$1,581.64 were incurred as a result of these changes. These costs included ministerial and departmental signage changes and new stationary and business cards.
