**Asked on 19 February 2020**

**MR P WEIR** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide statistics for the areas of Cambooya, Oakey, Pittsworth and Westbrook reported separately for the years 2017 to 2019 for the following criminal offences, (a) break and enter, (b) unlawful entry, (c) motor vehicle theft, (d) wilful damage and (e) sexual assault?

ANSWER:

This government remains committed to ensuring police have the resources and equipment they need to keep communities safe.

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that there are more Police in Queensland than ever before and in the Darling Downs District there are 440 approved police positions (including district and central functions) as at 29 February 2020, with another 8 positions to be delivered this year.

The QPS has advised that the Toowoomba Property Crime Unit continues to prioritise property-related matters across the Cambooya, Oakey, Pittsworth and Drayton areas.

I am also advised that the Toowoomba Child Protection and Investigation Unit places a high priority on its investigations.

Additionally, the Police Divisions in Cambooya, Oakey, Pittsworth and Drayton are supported by the Toowoomba Road Policing Unit, the Toowoomba Tactical Crime Squad, the Southern Region Rural Crime Squads and neighbouring Divisions. Police advise that the ability to draw on the collective mix of policing resources across the region achieves the optimum service delivery model for local communities.

I am advised by the QPS that the requested information is detailed in the table below:
