**MR M CRANDON** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

## **QUESTION:**

With reference to the former Chief Scientist of Queensland, Suzanne Miller—

Will the Minister advise (a) the date Ms Miller was appointed Chief Scientist, (b) the date Ms Miller was suspended, (c) the date Ms Miller's appointment ceased, (d) whether Ms Miller resigned, her employment was terminated or the contract expired, (e) the total length of time Ms Miller was suspended with pay, (f) the total amount of income received by Ms Miller while suspended and (g) whether, at any time, Ms Miller transitioned to suspension without pay and why?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for the question.

Professor Suzanne Miller was appointed to the role of Chief Scientist on 12 December 2016. Professor Miller's employment ceased on 13 December 2019. Employment matters relating to individual employees are confidential.

Professor Miller was appointed by the former LNP Government as the Director and Chief Executive Officer of Queensland Museum in July 2013 and resigned from that role on 1 June 2018.
