MR D CRISAFULLI ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL BUSINESS AND MINISTER FOR TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT (HON S FENTIMAN) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the vehicle access permits for Minjerribah Recreation Area—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by year) how much revenue over the forward estimates until 2022-23 is forecast to be raised from (a) permits for a term of one month or less and (b) permits for a term of more than one month?

ANSWER:

On 1 November 2019, a new monthly Vehicle Access Permit (VAP) option was made available for the Minjerribah Recreation Area, and a new fee was applied to the annual permit option.

The new monthly permit has proven popular, with about 82% of VAPs for the Minjerribah Recreation Area issued over the past three months being the monthly permit option.

Revenue forecasts are normally updated using data trends from the previous period. However, only three months of permit and revenue data is available for the new permit arrangements. The Department of Environment and Science will review revenue forecasts when additional data for sales of Minjerribah's VAPs is available and analysed.
