QUESTION:

With reference to community feedback regarding reports to Crime Stoppers not being issued to local police in the Pumicestone Electorate for follow up, for example 10 residents confirmed reporting a crime issue in a local neighbourhood over 10 times each yet local police reported only 12 instances of reporting recorded in two years—Will the Minister confirm that all reports made by the public to Crime Stoppers that relate to possible crime are in fact being received by local police in Queensland?

I have been assured by the Queensland Police Service that all reports made by the public to Crime Stoppers are tasked to local police.
