**MR S O'CONNOR** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister provide the calls for service data for each police division in the Gold Coast district categorised by offence type for the previous 12 months?

**ANSWER:**

The Queensland Police Service (QPS) has advised that calls for service data is drawn from the Queensland Police Computer Aided Dispatch (QCAD) system which is used in Police Communication Centres to help staff receive Triple Zero calls, perform officer safety checks, prioritise calls for service according to urgency and identify available or responsible police resources. I am advised that this data does not accurately represent offence type and that QPRIME is the principal system for recording reported offences.

Accordingly, I am advised by the QPS that the number of reported offences for each police division in the Gold Coast for 2019 sourced from QPRIME is detailed in the below table:
