DR M ROBINSON asked the Deputy Premier and Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

With reference to the experience to date of coronavirus at Redland Hospital— Will the Deputy Premier provide the data on the number of people that (a) tested positive, (b) received treatment, (c) required a ventilator and (d) were transferred to other hospitals?

ANSWER

- (a) In the period 1 March 2020 to 21 July 2020, 29 patients at the Redland Hospital have tested positive to COVID-19.
- (b) Of the 29 positive cases, 11 patients required hospital admission.
- (c) One.
- (d) Two.
