b.	Total number of approved applications involving native vegetation clearing	82 applications approved ¹
c.	Total hectares of native vegetation approved for clearing (approved applications only)	25510.53 hectares ²
d.	Average decision time for approved applications	23 business days
e.	Longest time taken for an individual application	60 business days

a.	Total number of applications lodged involving native vegetation clearing	111 applications lodged
b.	Total number of approved applications involving native vegetation clearing	112 applications approved ³
c.	Total hectares of native vegetation approved for clearing (approved applications only)	352.79 hectares
d.	Average decision time for approved applications	24 business days
e.	Longest time taken for an individual application	99 business days
