MR T NICHOLLS ASKED TREASURER, MINISTER FOR INFRASTRUCTURE AND PLANNING (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

Will the Treasurer advise the full costs of all consultants and/or contractors engaged in relation to the aborted Service Priority Review Office?

ANSWER:

At the 2019-20 Mid-Year Fiscal and Economic Review, the Service Priority Review Office (SPRO) announced savings of \$715,000,000 to be achieved in 2019-20.

These announced savings represented a return of more than 270 times on the cost of consultants and contractors engaged by the SPRO, or \$2,640,723 excluding GST.
