MS A LEAHY asked the Deputy Premier and Minister for Health and Minister for Ambulance Services (HON DR S MILES) –

QUESTION

With reference to all the FTEs in the South West Hospital and Health Service (SWHHS)—

Will the Deputy Premier advise how many of these FTE positions (a) are filled by staff who do not permanently have a residence in the SWHHS regional area and (b) currently fill their position on a fly in fly out or drive in drive out basis?

ANSWER

The South West Hospital and Health Service (HHS) has an establishment of 795 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) staff, comprising both clinical (e.g. medical, nursing and health practitioner) and non-clinical (operational and administrative) staff. The majority of staff live and work in the South West region.

I am advised that of the 795 FTE positions, 161 are filled by staff who do not have permanent residence in the South West HHS regional area. I am further advised that 31 staff currently fill their position on a fly in fly out, or drive in drive out basis.
