With reference to the Department of Transport and Main Roads issuing of unitemised receipts, which seems an anomaly that should be rectified, as all other businesses have to itemise their accounts for tax purposes—

Will the Minister change TMR's record keeping systems to comply with tax invoice and receipting requirements?

ANSWER:
