MR S O'CONOR ASKED THE MINISTER FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT, TOURISM AND INNOVATION (HON K JONES)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the number of enquiries that have been received by the department or by Economic Development Queensland from any party (individuals, corporations, other parties or organisations) seeking to initiate a project utilising the state-owned land within the Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct, prior to September 2019 and since September 2019 (reported separately by month)?

ANSWER:

Following the successful delivery of the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games, the Games Village developer handed back 9.5 hectares of State land, known as Lumina, to the former Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning on 9 January 2019.

Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) and the Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct Project Office together manage enquiries and investment attraction opportunities at Lumina.

Up to September 2019, EDQ and the Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct Project Office received approximately 35 enquiries (including prior to the land being handed back to the State in January 2019) and since September 2019, 186 enquiries have been received. A total of 221 enquiries have been received from parties seeking an opportunity at Lumina.
