Question on Notice No. 858 Asked on 12 August 2020

Mr S Bennett asked Premier and Minister for Trade (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise the number of veterans that have been employed since the start of the Veterans' Employment Pathway program by (a) department and (b) classification level (reported separately by financial year)?

ANSWER:

A total of 610 veterans have gained employment in the Queensland Government under the Veterans' Employment Pathway program in the period 24 July 2018 (when the program was announced) to 31 July 2020. Table 1 sets out the Queensland Government departments and entities in which veterans have been placed by financial year.
