MR T NICHOLLS ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to sections 229BB and 229BC of the Criminal Code relating to reporting belief of child sexual offences— Will the Minister advise the total number of disclosures made to police since the introduction of these offences?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service (QPS) advises that the manner in which data is recorded means that this data would require manual extraction and analysis, which the QPS considers would divert resources from important frontline service delivery and be an unjustifiable use of police resources.
