**MRS L GERBER** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)

QUESTION:

With reference to the matched election promise of \$2m to the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club ('Vikings Surf Club')—

Will the Minister (a) advise specifically when, in this financial year, the Vikings Surf Club will receive the funds, (b) advise if the Vikings Surf Club will receive the whole \$2m this financial year, (c) identify any limitations intended to be imposed on Vikings Surf Club in relation to the use of the funds and (d) confirm Vikings Surf Club will be able to use the funds to upgrade the junior clubhouse, including disability access, new change rooms, toilets, canteen and kitchen?

ANSWER:

In 2020, this government committed \$30 million to ensure that the vital operations and services provided by Surf Life Saving Queensland continue across the state, under a service agreement with Queensland Fire and Emergency Services.

This funding supports lifesaving surveillance and rescue services, surf safety awareness and education programs, frontline equipment, volunteer support programs and helicopter operations.

With regards to the specific funding for Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club the Member should direct this question to the Minister responsible for the provision of these facilities.
