**MR T MANDER** ASKED MINISTER FOR ENERGY, RENEWABLES AND HYDROGEN AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND PROCUREMENT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to corrective action taken by the Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC)—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by financial year since 1 July 2015) (a) how many prosecutions under the QBCC Act has the QBCC taken in court and (b) how many disciplinary actions under the QBCC Act has the QBCC taken?

**ANSWER**

The Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) has a range of regulatory options it can take in relation to offences committed by QBCC licensees under the *Queensland Building and Construction Commission Act 1991* (the QBCC Act) and the *Building Industry Fairness (Security of Payment) Act 2017* (the BIF Act), including Penalty Infringement Notices, warning notices as well as prosecution and disciplinary actions.
