MR A POWELL ASKED MINISTER FOR ENERGY, RENEWABLES AND HYDROGEN AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND PROCUREMENT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to the Queensland Government's total electrical power consumption—

Will the Minister advise, as at 1 February 2021, how much of the Queensland Government's total electrical power consumption is sourced from renewable sources?

ANSWER

The Department of Energy and Public Works holds data on a majority, though not all, of the Queensland Government's renewable energy consumption.

Based on the data held, for the period 1 January 2020 to 1 February 2021, 103,230 MWh was sourced from renewable generation.
