MR D JANETZKI ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise the number of new Incorporated Limited Partnerships registered in Queensland in each of these financial years (a) 2018-19, (b) 2019-20 and (c) 2020-21?

ANSWER:

An incorporated limited partnership (ILP) is a complex agreement between partners. All ILPs consist of at least 1 general partner and at least 1 limited partner.

There are many ways persons starting up a new business may decide to structure their business. Operating as an ILP is just one way.

I am advised the following numbers of ILPs were registered under the *Partnership Act 1891*:
