**MR D PURDIE** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide a list of intersections with smart pedestrian crossing technology together with the date of installation and cost for each intersection?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Ninderry for the question.

Smart pedestrian crossing technologies have been installed at the following four locations across Queensland.

Intersection	Location	Date of installation	Cost
Bruce Highway (Mulgrave Road) at Balaclava Primary School	Cairns	2 June 2021	\$19,480
Captain Cook Highway (Sheridan Street), south of Collins Avenue	Cairns	9 June 2021	\$19,436
Bruce Highway (Nebo Road), between George Street and Bagley Street	Mackay	25 June 2021	\$18,159
Cairns Western Arterial Road (Alfred Street), Sydney Street and Koch Street	Cairns	30 June 2021	\$23,361

A \$4.5 million rollout program is currently in development with further intersections to be fitted with this technology across Queensland. The rollout of this program is due to be completed in mid-2023.

The *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2021–22 to 2024–25* is the sixth record transport and roads infrastructure program in a row. The \$27.5 billion record program is estimated to support an average of 24,000 direct jobs over the life of the program.

Queensland's world-leading pandemic response has made it the place to be and, to support the State's population boom, significant road upgrades are being delivered as part of *Queensland's COVID-19 Economic Recovery Plan*. These upgrades provide immediate economic benefits, support more jobs and deliver ongoing benefits of vital infrastructure for years to come.
