MR J LANGBROEK ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General provide total numbers of Queensland residential bodies corporate and a breakdown of bodies corporate for each of the 93 Queensland electorates for the last three financial years?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Surfers Paradise for his question.

A residential body corporate is not a defined term under the *Body Corporate and Community Management Act 1997* (BCCM Act).

As there is no requirement under the BCCM Act for a body corporate to register with the Department of Justice and Attorney-General to identify it as a residential body corporate or its electorate, the Department is unable to provide the requested data. Certain data in relation to the number of registered community titles schemes established under the BCCM Act is published on the Titles Queensland website, and the Queensland Government Open Data Portal.
