QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 393 asked on 22 April 2020 and Question on Notice No. 11 asked on 23 February 2021—

Will the Deputy Premier advise whether a trustee has been appointed for Curlew Island and when signage to help protect the endangered birds on the island will be installed?

ANSWER:

The State Government acknowledges the importance of protecting the endangered bird species on Curlew Island. The government has therefore undertaken extensive consultation with a range of stakeholders to determine an appropriate trustee for the island. The trustee will be responsible for installation of any necessary signage.
