Question on Notice No. 1273 Asked on 26 October 2021

MR D LAST ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Coronial Inquest into the death of Logan Dreier which heard evidence relating to communications issues and made several recommendations relating to the Queensland Police Service—

Will the Minister advise

(a) the results of the trial into displaying call signs of police vehicles on the bonnets and roofs of those vehicles,

(b) when the current review into the Safe Driving and Pursuit Policy will be complete and whether the review will be made public,

(c) what steps have been taken to ensure the reliability of Police communications in Brisbane,

(d) what steps have been, or are being, taken to ensure that transmissions from 'COMCO' override all other transmissions, and

(e) whether training for officers to 'effectively use police communications' under stressful and difficult conditions will be introduced?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the findings of the Coronial Inquest were delivered on 14 October 2021, and that the Police Commissioner is reviewing those findings.
