### QUESTION

With reference to the total number of deaths in Queensland—

Will the Minister advise since 1 January 2021 the total number of (a) deaths, (b) reportable deaths, (c) deaths caused by myocarditis, (d) miscarriages and stillbirths, (e) deaths in aged care or residential facilities, (f) deaths in prisons and (g) deaths caused by 'sudden death' syndrome?
