MR N DAMETTO ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to damage caused by juvenile offenders to infrastructure and resources, including police vehicles— Will the Minister advise the total cost of damage to the State (broken down by financial year and asset type) for the last 5 years including the current financial year?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the total cost of damage to infrastructure and resources, including police vehicles, is recorded against the particular asset and that, determining the damage to those assets by a specific cohort of offender would require police to conduct a manual interrogation of data from multiple sources, including other government agencies, which is considered by the QPS to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
