MR S ANDREW ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to Queensland's 'Public Health and Social Measures' plan for '80 percent and beyond'—

Will the Minister advise whether unvaccinated Queenslanders will still be eligible for Medicare rebates on their non-emergency medical consultations with doctors, after the commencement of the new rules on 17 December 2021?

ANSWER

Yes. However, it should be noted that Medicare is a Commonwealth Government responsibility.
