**MR J KELLY** ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide an update on any plans for expanding Outside School Hours Care Services at Coorparoo State School?

ANSWER:

In 2020, the Palaszczuk Government committed \$17.91 million (excluding GST) to fund facility upgrades to increase capacity of Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) services at 48 schools in Queensland. This formed part of the \$45 million (excluding GST) allocated as part of the Great Schools Great Future policy.

Coorparoo State School was pledged \$500,000 (excluding GST) to explore options to increase the capacity of its OSHC service.

A site visit is currently being arranged with Coorparoo State School to analyse the needs of the service and scope potential works to expand the OSHC service.

The Department of Education is working to deliver these projects as quickly as possible.
