**DR C ROWAN** ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

With reference to Pullenvale State School's Infrastructure Master Plan—

Will the Minister outline what recommendations the Department of Education is implementing to complement Pullenvale State School's Traffic Management Plan?

ANSWER:

School road safety is a matter that requires whole-of-community awareness and commitment. Establishing a Safe School Travel (SafeST) Committee is the first step in identifying and addressing school safety concerns. The SafeST Committee will develop a school road safety action plan for implementing strategies and solutions.

Pullenvale State School does not currently have a SafeST Committee.

On 2 March 2021, the Department of Education met with the school to discuss their concerns about traffic congestion and safety issues at the school, including the process for establishing a SafeST Committee.

The department will continue to work with the school to identify solutions to its traffic congestion issues, including undertaking a site inspection, and liaising with relevant local stakeholders.
