QUESTION

Will the Minister provide a list (organised by Hospital and Health Service) of which Queensland Health facilities are using the 'Check-In Qld' App, and if any directive has been issued for the App to be implemented at Queensland Health Facilities?

ANSWER

I can confirm that the Director-General of Queensland Health and the Chief Health Officer have jointly issued a memorandum to the Chief Executives of all Queensland Hospital and Health Services regarding the use the Check In Queensland app at all HHS facilities and I strongly encourage all Queensland businesses and venues to use the application.

A number of Queensland Health facilities, or services delivered from facilities, have voluntarily registered for the Check In Qld app and are at varying stages of implementation. This Includes:
